

CLEANING WHEN OVERFILLED


Don't overwork your vacuum cleaner if it's full. Remember to

UP SPILLS

You've been lucky if you've gotten away with this. Liquids ruin the motor and can cause an electric shock!

RUNNING OVER THE CORD

Let the vacuum cord out of the way! You can peel the cable open and make it unsafe to use.
